

COURSE PLAN:

Requirements: In addition to the usual requirements for the Government concentration, students in the Data Science program take **four** letter-graded methods courses. (One fulfills the research-methods requirement for all concentrators, while the others are usually concentration electives.)

Ordinarily, two of these courses are Gov 50: Data Science for the Social Sciences and Gov 51: Data Analysis and Politics. However, students with prior coursework in statistics and data science may choose to take more advanced courses instead.
